DIVING FOR DEPTH IN MATHEMATICS

In light of the new curriculum, this training focuses on exploring teaching strategies which will aid in the delivery and assessment of secure and greater depth learning. Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract (CPA) pedagogies, formative assessment strategies, deeper learning questioning and mathematical thinking and reasoning will be explored. Suitable for all primary age ranges including EYFS.

STRENGTHENING MATHEMATICAL REASONING IN PRIMARY CLASSROOMS

This CPD session will explore what reasoning is and why it is important within the primary classroom. The session will unpick strategies to help children secure and deepen their mathematical vocabulary and understanding whilst also aiding teachers in the creation of secure and greater depth questioning. Suitable for all primary age ranges including EYFS.

ACCREDITED CEOP E-SAFETY TRAINING

Delivered by a CEOP-trained ambassador to provide an overview of CEOP and their educational programme. The session explores how young people are using technology, the associated risks of this and the preventative measures that can be taken. Course completion will result in a CEOP accredited attendance certificate and further access to online resources.

ACHIEVING BEST PRACTICE IN EYFS

This course will look in depth at the what, how, when, where and who of teaching in EYFS and how, when all these pieces are joined together, best practice can be achieved. During the session participants will visit the Foundation Stage Unit at Robert Wilkinson Primary Academy and there will be opportunities for professional discussions and putting theory into practice.

EFFECTIVE INTERACTIONS OR INEFFECTIVE INTERRUPTIONS?

To interact or not to interact? That is the question! How should we intervene? When should we intervene? Where should we intervene? Should we intervene at all? This course will discuss the art of effective interactions versus ineffective interruptions. There will be opportunities for professional discussions, active learning and to visit the Foundation Stage Unit on site to put skills and theory into practice.

CODING MADE EASY

This session provides teachers with a comprehensive understanding of coding in the computing curriculum and knowledge of what needs to be taught and which free or licensed programs to use. The hands-on workshop will help teachers to learn by doing and give plenty of practical advice. There will additionally be resources to take away. Sessions available in KS1 and KS2.

A PRACTICAL GUIDE TO MUSIC IN THE NATIONAL CURRICULUM – KS1

Delegates will gain a better understanding of the musical dimensions in Key Stage 1 National Curriculum and an insight into musical awareness, listening and its impact on the wider curriculum. Guidance on resources and putting planning into practice will be plentiful during this active session.

ELKLAN SPEECH & LANGUAGE SUPPORT FOR 5-11S

This 10-week ELKLAN accredited course is for all staff working with 5-11 year old children in primary settings. It will provide information and strategies to develop the communication skills of all children, especially those with speech, language and communication needs.

HOW TO SET UP AND RUN 5 ENCHANTING WOODLAND ADVENTURES WHERE IMAGINATION SOARS...

This session aims to bring a connection to nature back into the lives of children in a way that is engaging, educational and fun. On each of the adventures a tale will be told to inspire the children, setting the scene for the mysteries that await them in the adventure... This session will equip participants with a wealth of new ideas, activities, games and crafts which are both easy and practical to recreate on any school grounds. Suitable for EYFS and KS1.

IN-SCHOOL TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Academy Specialists are available for in-school training and support programmes. The following sessions are led by Emma Davies, SLE for the Ebor Teaching Schools Alliance and Primary Science Specialist for the Ebor Academy Trust.

BE GONE THE PASSIVE LEARNER!

This session explores how children learn best. Staff will have the opportunity to experience active learning strategies that span all ages and curriculum subjects to promote active learning in the classroom.

CURIOSITY IS KEY!

This session is designed to explore a range of exciting 'hooks' to emotionally engage children in learning, foster curiosity and mess with their minds! You will learn how to use curiosity boards to provide a structure for critical thinking.

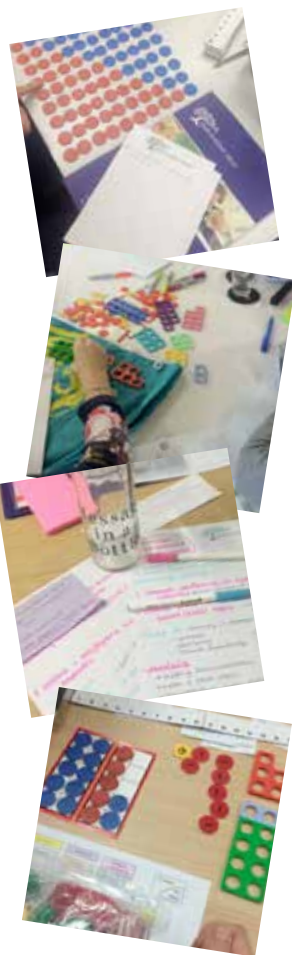
