Are you interested in CPD and Leadership? Here's how to discover a unique opportunity which could take you to far-flung places!

The Trust is seeking expressions of interest from **four** teaching practitioners across our regional hubs to become CPD Leaders within their schools and to join our Trust CPD strategy group.

We are keen to develop a Trust CPD strategy which identifies areas of need whilst considering how CPD is managed and coordinated within school settings.

The role is school based and would work within the normal parameters of your current commitments. Individuals should be a Middle or Senior Leader and should have completed an NPQ accreditation – or be willing to pursue this in the near future.

This is an opportunity to develop leadership skills within a school setting and beyond a school.

The CPD Leaders will:

- Receive three days specialist training on the Huntington Leading Learning Course
- Attend three half-days CPD Strategy Meetings
- Attend a half-day CPD Lead Launch Event
- Have an opportunity to complete an appropriate national professional qualification either NPQML, NPQSL or NPQH
- Be encouraged to engage in academic research and contribute to our TSA Research Lead blog and to collaborate with local, national and international partners.

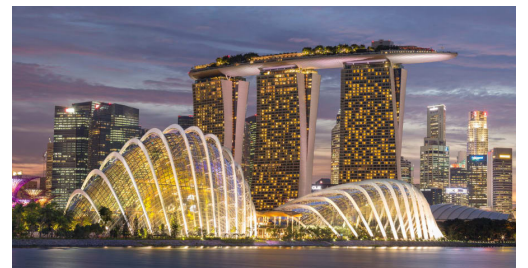
The school will:

- Gain a highly skilled leader who can help the SLT shape and develop the CPD offer within their setting
- Agree to release the member of staff for the training and CPD strategy, receiving £500 to cover costs
- Agree to release the member of staff for five days to undertake international research (cover costs are not provided).

International Partnership

It is anticipated that the CPD strategy group will take part in a trip to Singapore in February 2019.

The Trust will coordinate the research trip with the Singapore education ministry. Flights and accommodation will be paid, participants paying for their own food, any internal travel and incidental expenditure.
